## **RATIONALE** :

Student attendance, along with effective teaching, has the greatest influence on student engagement and achievement. All students must be present at school so they can participate and engage in learning.

### PURPOSE :

- 1. To focus on student attendance as a foundation for student engagement and achievement
- 2. To develop and implement a robust attendance management plan and effective processes
- 3. To improve student attendance.

### LEGISLATION:

Education and Training Act 2020 (Sections 36, 48, 49 and 242)

#### **GUIDELINES**:

- School staff (including the Attendance Officer) will work proactively with families and whanau to ensure regular attendance and punctuality. Where appropriate, Truancy Services will be used to assist.
- 2. Class teachers will keep accurate records of attendance and lateness via the Student management System.
- 3. New Plymouth Boys' High School does not allow part time students. All students are required to attend all classes they are timetable for.
- 4. Unexplained absences will be managed as per procedures outlined in the Managing Student Behaviour Manual.
- 5. Requests for leave must be directed to the Headmaster.
