RATIONALE :

To promote an internet and cyber safe school environment at New Plymouth Boys' High School.

NPBHS defines internet and cyber safety as being secure and safe online.

PURPOSE :

- 1. To educate students, staff and the school community about the safe and responsible use of information and communication technologies
- 2. To develop and maintain procedures around the safe and responsible use of the digital technologies, school's network and systems and the internet
- 3. To actively promote a safe school environment for all our digital citizens providing helpful resources, such as those provided by <u>Netsafe</u>
- 4. To share clear guidelines about acceptable and unacceptable use of the technology, outlining requirements and expectations

GUIDELINES :

Accordingly, the school will :

- 1. Follow clear guidelines about publishing personal information online
- 2. Ensure a clear process is in place for dealing with breaches of the policy or agreements
- 3. The Senior Leadership Team (SLT) will ensure all staff are made aware of the responsibilities and expectations held of them and what each means in practice, in relation to the staff guidelines for the safe use of digital technology
- 4. Require the ICT Manager to maintain and monitor a secure and safe technology environment
