2. To describe student achievement in relation to the National Certificate of Educational Achievement or any alternative system of qualifications or assessment.
3. To advise parents/caregivers and students on ways to improve their student's learning.

GUIDELINES :

1. The School will report regularly to parents/caregivers on the performance of their son(s)
2. The School will provide the opportunity for parents/caregivers to engage with their teachers on a regular basis
3. The School will communicate these opportunities to parents/caregivers
