Terms and Definitions Sheet

International Student Contract Suite

(For the purposes of the International Tuition Contract, Accommodation Agreement, and Designated Caregiver Agreement)

For the purposes of these agreements, the following terms shall have the following meanings unless the context explicitly requires otherwise:

1. Primary Parties & Roles

Term	Definition
School	New Plymouth Boys' High School.
Student	An international student is defined as a person who is not a domestic student and who is enrolled or enrolling with an approved education provider.
Parent /Parents	The Student's biological or legally adoptive parent(s) referred to in the Application Form.
Legal Guardian	The person or persons legally designated as the guardian of the Student in their home country, possessing the legal right to make decisions regarding the Student's care, education, and well-being (includes parents where applicable).
Designated Caregiver	A relative or close family friend designated in writing by a parent or legal guardian of an international learner under 18 years as the caregiver and accommodation provider for that learner.
Residential Caregiver	For an international learner aged under 18, this means: (a) a homestay carer; (b) a licensed school hostel manager or other person responsible for the care of international learners in a licensed school hostel; (c) a designated caregiver; (d) in the case of temporary accommodation, a supervisor responsible for the care of international learners.

2. Contracts, Agreements & Documentation

1. **Application Form:** The New Plymouth Boys' High School International Enrolment Application Form.

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2. **Contract of Enrolment:** The agreement between the Student, New Plymouth Boys' High School, and the Parents governing the Student's Tuition.
3. **Accommodation Agreement:** The agreement between the Student, the School, and the Parents regarding accommodation during the tenure of the enrolment contract.
4. **Residential Caregiver Agreement:** An agreement between the School and the Residential Caregiver.
5. **Offer of Place:** An offer issued by the School to the Student for provision to Immigration New Zealand to obtain a qualifying student visa,
6. **Code:** The *Education (Pastoral Care of Tertiary and International Learners) Code of Practice 2021*, as updated from time to time and available online via [\(Pastoral Care of Tertiary and International Learners\)](#).

3. Accommodation & Care Facilities

1. **Accommodation:** The residential accommodation provided to the Student.
2. **Accommodation Provider:** The Residential Caregiver provided by the School
3. **Boarding:** Refers specifically to the New Plymouth Boys' High School hostel.
4. **Homestay:** Accommodation provided to an international learner in the residence of a family or household in which no more than four (4) international learners are accommodated.
5. **Licensed Hostel:** A school hostel that is licensed under the *Education (Hostels) Regulations 2005*.
6. **House Rules:** The rules and guidelines put in place by an accommodation provider governing student behaviour within the residence.

4. Academic, Financial & Operational Terms

1. **Tuition:** The education of the Student at the School or, where appropriate, education provided by the School through online, remote, or distance learning.
2. **Period of Enrolment:** Any period for which Fees are paid. Enrolment commences on the course start date stated in the Offer of Place and concludes on the course end date stated in the Offer of Place, or on an earlier date as agreed by the parties or terminated by the School in accordance with the Contract of Enrolment or Accommodation Agreement.
3. **Fee:** Fees payable by the Parents to the School as specified in the Fee Schedule and Invoice.
4. **Fee Schedule:** The schedule detailing charges for Tuition, Accommodation, and other fees, available from the School on request.
5. **Disciplinary Action:** Actions, including termination of the Agreement and other measures that correspond to suspension, expulsion, and exclusion if applied to a Domestic Student.
6. **Termination:** The formal termination of the Agreement.
7. **Welfare Issue:** Any situation where the School holds a concern regarding the Student's safety or well-being, or where the School considers it cannot meet its statutory obligations under the Code and/or the Act with respect to the Student's health and safety
